The Japanese Government set up the Energy/Environment Conference on October 28, 2011 in order to establish a long term energy plan, and has been engaged in discussions since. On June 29, the government announced three options for its future energy and environment plan, and opened up discussions with Japanese citizens before making its final decision.

Subsequently, the "Mayors for a Nuclear Power Free Japan" network will be holding a seminar, with Professor Ueda Kazuhiro, specialist in environmental economics, and drafting and presenting its proposal to the government. Messages from overseas cities such as Vienna will also be announced.
